
CUSTOM DESIGN BEGINS

Once existing layout is reviewed, a design fee will be proposed at which time you can decide to proceed.



DESIGN PACKET APPROVAL

Once design approval is achieved, an invoice will be sent and is due in full. We will send a signoff packet. Your signoff packet will include the plan and elevation list. Once order is placed, your design fee will be credited to your order.



DELIVERY TIMELINE

STEPS TO MEASURE YOUR SPACE

Step One: Your Kitchen Shape

Draw your kitchen as a box showing all walls and openings. Make sure to mark all openings with labels (ie: door, window, etc.).

Step Two: Measuring

Go from edge to edge with a tape measure and mark everything. This includes wall lengths, opening lengths, ceiling heights and appliance spaces.

Step Three: Your Layout if you have an idea or change you want to make, let us know! Feel free to draw your ideas of what you would like to include in your new kitchen.

Step Four: Appliances

Make note of the sizes and specs of any appliances you have or plan on purchasing for your new kitchen.
